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Eagle Scout Project Benefits HHCC

Noah Lee, a camper and SIT'er who has been involved with Horton Haven for over four years, completed his Eagle project for the camp this past spring. An Eagle project is a service project benefiting a non-profit organization to show the leadership capabilities of an Eagle candidate. The rank of Eagle is the highest rank attainable in Boy Scouts.

His project was to improve the hiking trails at the camp. The project entailed: clearing the trails, putting up map kiosks at the beginnings and endings of the trails, installing benches along the trails, and making navigational signs for the trails.

About 21 volunteers helped with the project,

and over 143 hours were used planning and working on the project.
